

Terms & Conditions

Carousel Clothing will take top quality women's clothes, shoes and accessories for a maximum of six weeks. Items will be sold on a 60/40 basis – with 40 per cent of the price going to you in the form of a cheque and 60 per cent in commission to Carousel Clothing. Carousel Clothing will make a donation of two per cent of their profits to the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF).

Items must be:

- Not more than two years old & in season.
- Clean, or dry cleaned, in excellent condition and pressed.
- Not smell of cigarette smoke or other odours.
- Good makes, ie top end High Street or designer, not supermarket brands etc.
- We will not accept counterfeit goods and you may be asked to show provenance.
- Worth more than £10.

Damage and liability

- Carousel Clothes cannot accept any liability for any loss, theft or damage of any type to the items left for sale.
- Unfortunately items do go missing and you must be aware that this can happen before you hand over your items.
- Your items may get handled by other people and you may want to make your own insurance arrangements for wear and tear as well as loss.

How does it work?

- You will have a receipt which will give a date by which you must collect your items if they haven't sold or any money that is owing to you.
- We cannot issue a reminder, it is up to you to note this date.
- Please give us one day's notice before you come in to collect.
- **TWO WEEKS** after your collection date, if not collected, your unsold items will be given to charity. We cannot for storage reasons hang on to uncollected items any longer!
